

## **CHEC Student Banquet Dress Code 2023**

The CHEC Banquet is a formal event and requires ladies and gentlemen to dress in modest, formal/semi-formal attire. We have some guidelines to help you choose your attire wisely and appropriately so that you may enjoy your evening. You will be asked to change or leave banquet if your attire breaks the dress code.

### **Ladies**

#### Acceptable Attire

- Long gowns
- The minimum length for dresses is three inches above the top of the knee. See-through fabric will not be considered in determining the length of the gown.
- Spaghetti straps and strapless gowns that are modest and concealing.
- Formal jumpsuit

#### Unacceptable Attire

- Plunging necklines (rule of thumb: if you can bend over without needing to cover yourself with your hand, your neckline is appropriate)
- Slits more than three inches above the top of the knee
- Open back that goes below the waist or extends into the sides
- See through gowns
- Jeans, pants, trousers
- Visible tattoos or body piercings
- Menswear
- Midriff baring

### **Gentlemen**

#### Acceptable Attire

- Tuxedos, dress suits, formal military uniforms
- Neckties, bowties, bolo ties
- Collared, button up shirts
- Dress shoes or dress boots

#### Unacceptable Attire

- T-shirts
- Visible tattoos or body piercings
